

BIOGRAPHY – Vladimir Stančić, PhD

Vladimir Stančić was born in 1985 in Kragujevac, Serbia, where he finished his high school with honours. He graduated from the Faculty of Economics, the University of Belgrade, majoring Accounting, Auditing and Financial Management in 2008 earning the GPA of 8.63.

In 2009/10 academic year, he enrolled in the PhD program **Accounting** at the Faculty of Economics, University of Niš. He passed all the examinations with the average mark 10.00 and successfully defended his PhD thesis titled “*Financial-accounting aspects of creating the investment portfolio of life insurance companies*” in 2016.

After graduation, he worked in the manufacturing and service industry for 4 years. In 2013 he was hired by the Faculty of Economics, University of Kragujevac, as a Teaching Assistant at the Department of Accounting, Auditing and Business Finance. He was promoted to an Assistant Professor in 2017 at the Department of Accounting, Auditing and Business Finance and the Department of Finance, Financial Institutions and Insurance for the courses Insurance and Financial Institutions Accounting.

His areas of research and scientific interests are the investment of insurance funds, investment portfolio optimization for insurance companies and investment risk management.

He published several scientific articles and is an authorized court expert for the economic-financial field.
